- 3-watercolor paint sets

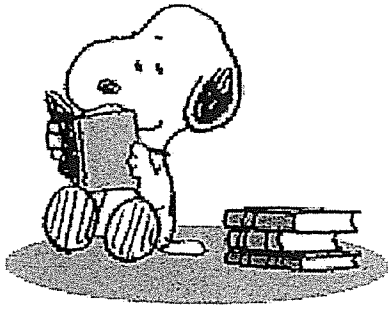

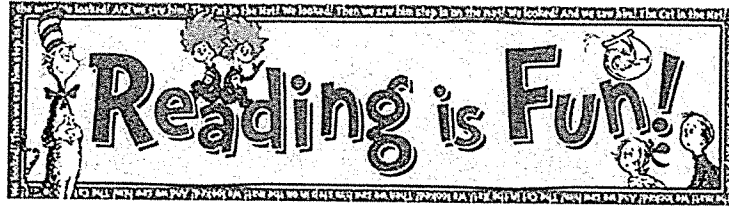
